

# Sorvete top

35



# YARN

3 (4, 5) skeins of Rosários 4 Damasco yarn (70% cotton, 30% linen; 50 g/200 m).

# **NEEDLES**

3 mm and 3,5mm circular needles *(if necessary, adjust the needle size to match the gauge).* 

# GAUGE

20 sts and 32 rows - 10x10 cm in stockinette stitch with 3,5 mm needle, washed and blocked (*it's important to wash and block your swatch in order to get the correct gauge*).

## NOTIONS

Stitch markers, tapestry needle, waste yarn.

### SIZES

S, M, L.

# FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

85 (101, 114) cm final bust measurements (refer to schematic for more measurements).

# **INSTRUCTION**

With smaller needle, cast on 72 (86, 96) sts, **pm**, cast on 72 (86, 96) sts. [total 144 (172, 192) sts] Join to knit in the round, making sure that the cast on edge is not twisted and place beginning of round marker (BOR). Work in 1x1 rib [k1, p1] for 5 cm.

Change to 3,5 mm and work increases for the body:

Rnd 1 (increases): \* [ K9 (8, 8), M1r]  $\times$  8 (10, 12), K0 (6, 0), slm, repeat from \* once.

#### [80 (96, 108) sts in front and back]

Work in stockinette stitch until top measures 33 (33, 35) cm from cast on.

Now divide the work in 4 pieces (2 triangles for the front + 2 triangles for the back) and work back and forth, flat.

**Divide Work:** count 40 (48, 54) sts and leave them on the working needles for right front piece; slip next 40 (48, 54) sts to waste yarn and leave on hold for left front piece; remove marker, slip next 40 (48, 54) sts to waste yarn and leave on hold for right back piece; slip next 40 (48, 54) sts to waste yarn and leave on hold for left back piece, remove BOR.

# **RIGHT FRONT**

Work decreases for armhole and neckline:

Row 1 (RS): ssk, yo, ssk, K32 (40, 46), K2tog, yo, K2tog.

Row 2 (WS): sl1, P to last st, sl1.

Row 3: ssk, yo, ssk, K to last 4 sts, K2tog, yo, K2tog. Row 4: sl1, P to last st, sl1.

Repeat rows 3 - 4, 6 (9, 12) more times. [24 (26, 26) sts].

Work decreases for neckline only:

Row 1: ssk, yo, ssk, k to last 2 sts, yo, K2tog.

Row 2: sl1, P to last st, sl1.

Repeat rows 1 - 2, 15 (17, 17) more times. [8 sts] Bind off all sts.

#### LEFT FRONT

Slip the 40 (48, 54) sts on hold to the needles and work the decreases for armhole and neckline:

Row 1 (RS): ssk, yo, ssk, K32 (40, 46), k2tog, yo, K2tog.

Row 2 (WS): sl1, P to last st, sl1.

Row 3: ssk, yo, ssk, K to last 4 sts, k2tog, yo, K2tog.

**Row 4:** sl1, P to last st, sl1K Repeat rows 3 - 4, 6 (9, 12) more times. [24 (26, 26) sts]

Work decreases for neckline only:

Row 1: ssk, yo, k to last 4 sts, K2tog, yo, K2tog.

Row 2: sl1, P to last st, sl1.

Repeat rows 1 - 2, 15 (17, 17) more times. [8 sts] Bind off all sts.

#### **RIGHT BACK**

Slip the 40 (48, 54) sts on hold to the needles and work the same instruction as for the right front piece.

#### LEFT BACK

Slip the 40 (48, 54) sts on hold to the needles and work the same instruction as for the left front piece.

#### FINISHING

Seam shoulders, weave in all ends and block opening the yarnovers around the edges.

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# **ABBREVIATIONS**

K: knit P: purl cm: centimeters st/sts: stitch/stitches Rnd/rnds: round/rounds pm: place marker slm: slip marker BOR: begining of round marker yo: yarn over K2tog: knit 2 stitches together ssk: slip, slip, knit (slip a stitch a as if to knit insert left needle into

**ssk:** slip, slip, knit (slip a stitch as if to knit, slip a second stitch as if to knit, insert left needle into the front of the slipped stitches and knit)

SI1: slip 1 st as if to purl

**M1R:** make one right (insert the left-hand needle, from back to front, under the strand of yarn which runs between the stitch just worked and the next stitch on the left-hand needle and knit this new stitch through the front loop; on wrong side: purl the new stitch through the front loop)

Stockinette stitch: knit on right side rows and purl on wrong side rows (when working in the round knit all rounds)
